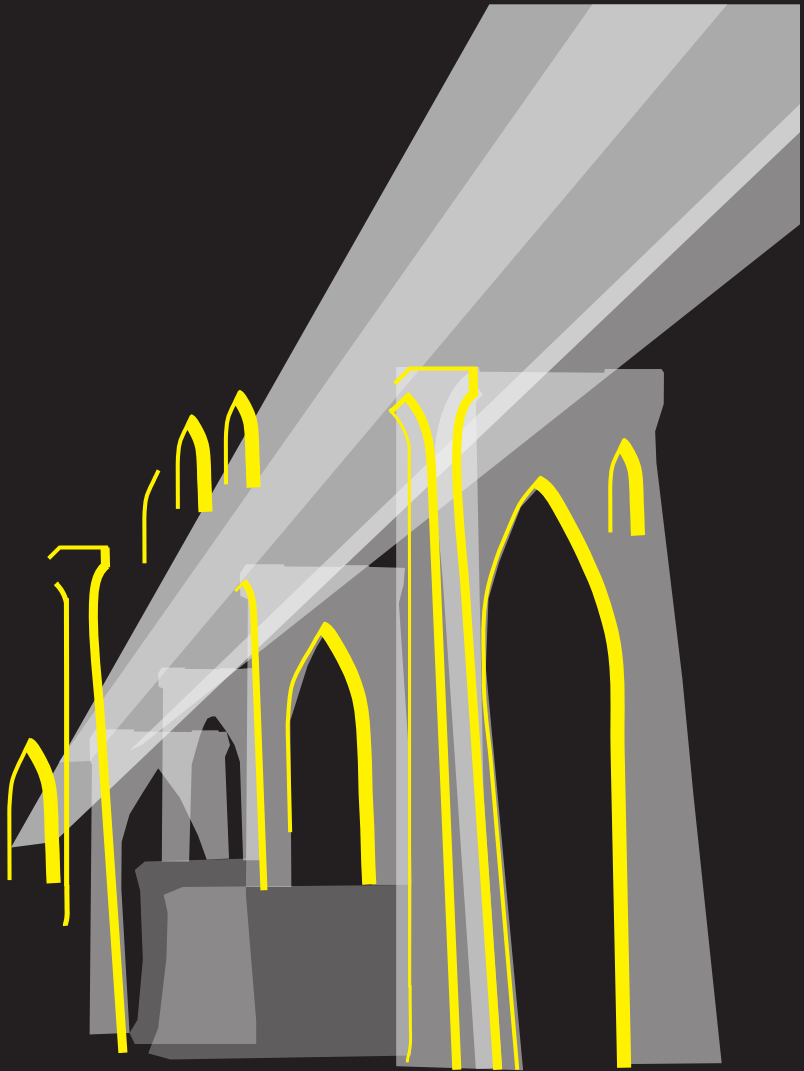

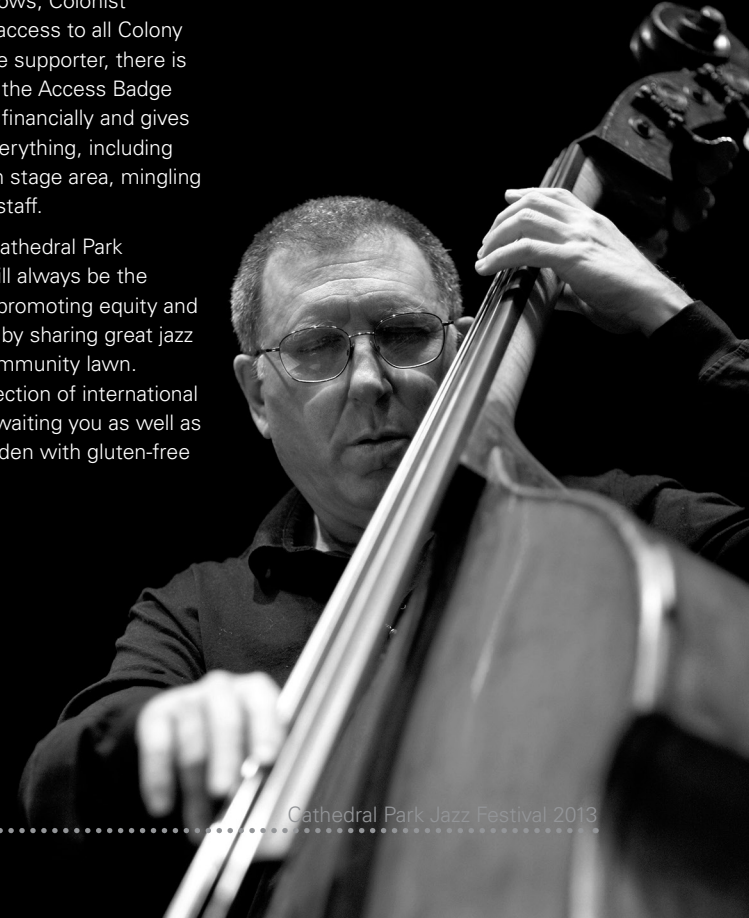


WELCOME

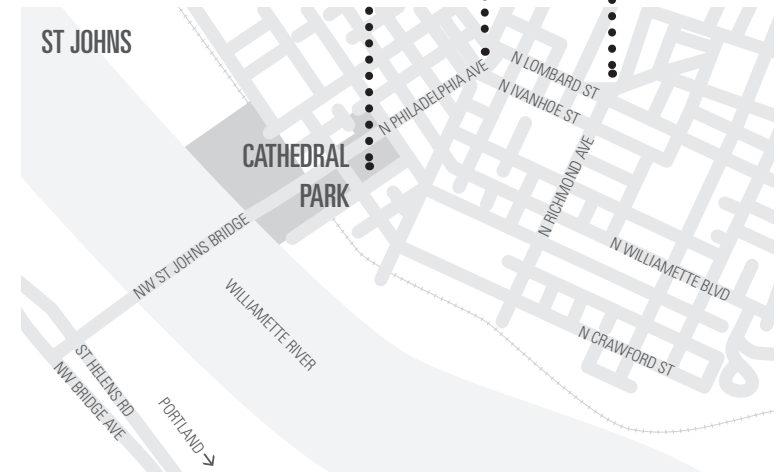
